The Long Island Builders Institute requests very favorable action on the part of the county legislature today for the following resolutions:

Finally, the time has come to take the last actions necessary to complete the financing to create a system to dispose of all the wastewater from the Ronkonkoma Hub Project. We urge your support for Resolutions 1953 and 1974 which will finish the financing job.

Second, LIBI urges support of the Resolution 1870 which will set new standards and procedures for Article 6 wastewater treatment requirements. LIBI Has been a member of the Article Six Steering Committee from the beginning and supports these new initiatives which will require new I/A systems from certain commercial projects, require reporting of on-site pump outs to the health department and would require the updating of systems which meet certain failure standards. All of these initiatives are contained in 1870, are necessary first step in reducing nitrogen flow into our groundwater and deserves support from the County Legislature
