

GEO'S Report

am honored to begin this year serving as the new CEO and hope to continue the tremendous growth and success that LIBI

experienced with our prior CEO, Mitch Pally at the helm. Working together we can continue to build upon the many accomplishments that have been made to promote and advance the residential building and development industry across Long Island.

LIBI is considered one of the premier lobbying organizations, not only on Long Island but across the state, and has an influential voice with decision-makers at the federal, state, and local levels. That cannot happen without the significant support of its members. Our members are the lifeblood of this organization and your active involvement from serving on committees, speaking at community hearings, sponsoring and attending our events, and supporting our political action committee is the fuel that drives us forward.

Under the leadership of our incoming president, Vincent Calvosa, we are looking to expand our member's involvement in LIBI with our Women's Council, Young Professionals Council, Remodeler's Council, and East End Council, along with other educational program offerings. Be assured, there will be plenty of opportunities for you to be involved.

As we enter 2023, housing promises to be a hotly debated topic. During her State of the State address earlier this month, Governor Hochul unveiled a bold plan to build 800,000 new housing units across the state in the next decade.

In order to achieve that goal every municipality across Long Island would need to grow its housing stock by 3% over a three-year period. For reference, over the past three years, Long Island has only grown .56%, so there is certainly room to improve. Municipalities that fail to achieve or make a good faith effort to hit their targets could then have a state board override their local zoning control and approve certain projects.

Additionally, areas within .5 mile of LIRR rail stations would be rezoned to allow for higher density. To help facilitate this growth, the state would provide a \$250 million infrastructure improvement fund and an additional \$20 million for planning.

We support the Governor's vision and determination to address our region's housing crisis, but believe flexibility, additional incentives and the buy in from local officials and communities are essential to any plan.

Our 650+ members, their employees, and their families represent a broad and powerful voice we must be ready to activate as this critical debate plays out over the next few months at the state and local levels and LIBI will keep you informed and provide opportunities for engagement.

Again, my thanks to all of you for your continued support and for having the trust in me to lead this organization forward. My mission is to ensure that each of you get value and fulfilment out of your membership in our organization and together, I hope to accomplish great things in 2023.







Dimitrios "Jim" Tsunis Sr., beloved father of LIBI member Jimmy Tsunis of The Northridge Group, passed away peacefully in his home on December 25th, 2022. Mr. Tsunis' parents emigrated from Platanos, Greece and settled in Brooklyn where he was born. He loved baseball and was an avid New York Yankees fan. This love of the game brought him into a summer job as a bat boy for the Brooklyn Dodgers.

After World War II, he signed up for the U.S. Marine Corps, where he served in Pearl Harbor, China and Guam before leaving to start his long career in the restaurant business. He ran the Rotisserie Restaurant with his brother Charlie until the sale of the restaurant, and eventually becoming a salesman for National Dairy. After becoming familiar with the dairy industry working for National Dairy, Crestwood Dairy and Sheffield Farms, he purchased Presske's Dairy, which he ran along with his many other businesses.

The 1960's saw Jim switching gears to begin working in the real estate development and banking industry and was quickly appointed to the Board of Directors of Tinker National Bank. During this time, he partnered with Whitey Ford, NY Yankees Hall of Fame Pitcher, on many development projects, including the Ford Professional Building in Port Jefferson Station.

Jim and Whitey partnered with Edward Long and began a legacy of endeavors, including a fundraising golf tournament, "The Pinter Tournament of Stars" which led into the founding of the Long Island Charities Foundation, which raises money for a wide variety of charitable organizations on Long Island

He was a member of the Centereach Chamber of Commerce, Centereach-Lake Grove Lions Club, the Association of Developmentally Disabled Children, Port Jefferson Elk's Club, the Adelphi College Fund Raising Committee and also served as Vice-President of the Harbor Hills Country Club. He was also a member of the Brookhaven Industrial Development Corporation, being appointed by Governor Nelson Rockefeller. He was also a driving force in launching what would become Dowling College.

Jim was an avid golfer and never missed an opportunity to hit the greens even into his 90's.

The Long Island business community will not be the same without Mr. Tsunis' expert guidance and experience.
