GEO'S Report

Looking Back On My First 100 Days

At one of our recent LIBI functions a member came up and asked me how my first 100 days were going. Until that point, I hadn't even thought of it, but it gave me a moment

to reflect. The last three months have been a whirlwind of developing new relationships, learning new issues and understanding the value that LIBI provides to its members, the home building industry and to Long Island community. I was left a solid foundation to work from, but I see the potential for even greater growth and success in the future.

From day one of my start here, we have been in the middle of a statewide discussion and plan to double the number of new housing units over the next decade. As a building organization, we have supported the overall goal, but have made our concerns clear that a mandated approach that could override local zoning would be problematic and could ultimately lead to lawsuits that result in stagnation and fewer projects getting done.

As of this writing, we are still waiting on a state budget that is now weeks late and as much as we are hoping for a victory on housing policy, we continue to fight to keep Good Cause Eviction out of the final deal. We have worked with a statewide group of organizations to oppose Good Cause, knowing it would be a devasting blow to the housing industry and result in less housing being built.

One of the most exciting events I have participated in was the 31st LIBI Trade Expo held at the end of March. Over 95 exhibitors attended and nearly 800 people came through the doors. Going into the event, the expectations were mixed, but the results blew everyone away. The feedback was unanimously positive from all who attended. The vibe and energy in the room was palpable and you saw many people engrossed in conversation and smiling. Additionally, Long Island Home Builders Care (LIHBC), the charitable arm of LIBI, teamed with Canine Companions, a leading provider and trainer of service dogs to assist people with disabilities, to present a special demonstration

of their skilled dogs. LIHBC also donated a custom-built staircase, by Deer Park Stairs, to Canine Companions to assist in their training.

The trade show committee did a phenomenal job putting the event together especially the promotion via social media. Many people approached me and told me it was the best show in years, if not ever. We have already booked the venue again for next year and are looking to go bigger and better.

The formation of new committees that we outlined at the beginning of the year is also off and running. I have attended meetings with each of the Women's, Young Professionals', Remodelers' and East End Committees and they are all actively engaged and eager to contribute to LIBI.

Finally, the 2023 political season is off and running. Over the last few weeks, candidates have collected and filed their petitions to get on the ballot and fundraising events have begun in earnest. The LIBI Political Action Committee continues to examine all the local races and will support candidates who support our priorities. The election of the next Suffolk County Executive will be the marquee matchup of the year. The LIBI PAC has held separate meet and greets with both Brookhaven Supervisor Ed Romaine, the Republican nominee and Dave Calone, the Democratic nominee. We will hold additional meetings and a formal screening process in the late summer/early fall and encourage members to attend.

On April 26th, the PAC will host a special educational event to discuss the political climate with a distinguished group of former Long Island leaders; Congressman Peter King, Congressman Tom Suozzi, Nassau County Executive Laura Curran and Senate Majority Leader John Flanagan. Getting this caliber of expertise together for one night promises to make this a can't miss event.

With all this going on, I am optimistic, energized, and excited about LIBI's future. I want to thank our members who have provided their time, knowledge and guidance to me over the past few months and I look forward to continuing to work with you all for the betterment of our industry.


There are exciting things happening at LIBI and the growth of the committees is
